10 THINGS TO ASK SEIU

- 1. Why hasn't the union informed IPs of their right to choose for themselves whether to pay union dues under the U.S. Supreme Court's ruling in *Harris v. Quinn?*
- Why has SEIU 775 spent hundreds of thousands of dollars of members' dues on private law firms to fight efforts by the Freedom Foundation to inform IPs of their rights?
- 3. Why is the union being sued by caregivers for illegally taking dues without their permission?
- 4. Why did the union illegally conceal \$1.4 million in political campaign contributions, leading to a \$44,000 fine after it was sued by the state Attorney General?
- 5. Why have union reps been caught on tape lying to IPs about their rights?
- 6. Why did the union tell IPs it was fighting to get them overtime when the union's lobbyist supported legislation to limit IPs' hours?
- 7. Why is the union sending millions of dollars of IPs' dues out of state?
- 8. Why are SEIU 775 dues higher than any other SEIU union in the Pacific Northwest and twice as high as dues for state employees?
- 9. Why does SEIU 775 need to collect \$50 million from IPs to negotiate a contract with the state once every two years? Unlike traditional unions, SEIU 775 can't process workplace disputes or grievances because IPs are employed by their clients, not the state.
- **10.** Why do union dues keep going up when the union has \$11.5 million in the bank?
