Protecting state employees private information

PRA is vital to a healthy democracy, but public servants should feel safe at work.

Under PRA, the public can request certain records, but personal information, including birth dates, about employees should be exepted.

- Birth dates should be no different than an address or social security number, which are already exempted.
- No one should have to risk identity theft, stalking, domestic violence or workplace harassment because they choose to serve the public.

The Supreme Court case was filed by the Freedom Foundation – an antigovernment special interst – in order to contact state union members to alert them about the right to not pay union dues.

• This is not done in good faith for transparency, but as a political tactic to reduce union participation while putting individual people at risk.
