We are hearing it right now and I know we have a lot of emails about it. It had some bi-partisan support from ITED, so we will probably move it today or tomorrow out of Appropriations.

1. Extending current exemption for teachers, etc. and employee data that is not needed for the public employees to do their job or retirees who are no longer in their public job.
2. Yet still gives Media access to malfeasance
3. Not a spat between unions and the Freedom Foundation, but we need this bill to keep employees and retirees safe.
